1. India has received a Loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) for financing the Sustainable Coastal Protection and Management Program - Project 1. Part of this facility will be used for payments under the contract of construction of 2 multipurpose geotextile reefs and 4 inshore berms in Ullal, Karnataka, India .The Project Director, Project Management Unit, Ports and Inland Water Transport Department, Karnataka invites sealed bids from experienced and eligible bidders for the above work package.
2. To be qualified under the packages, bidder should as a minimum meet the following requirements:(a) has average annual construction turnover of US\$ 8.40 million for last 3 years (b) has available cash flow of US\$2.8 million (c) has experience as contractor, management contractor, or subcontractor within last ten years for at least one civil work contract amounting to \$ 13.4 million that have been successfully or are substantially completed (d) has specific experience in having completed not less than one offshore geotextile project using sand filled geotextiles, in not less than 4 Meters depth of water at low water. Each project should have not less than a volume of 3000 M3. However for complete eligibility and qualification requirements, bid document should be referred.
3. International Competitive Bidding (ICB) will be conducted in accordance with ADB's **Single stage - Two envelope** bidding procedure and is open to all bidders from eligible member countries of ADB.

Five thousand only) or in equivalent US dollar currency starting from 09 December 2011 to 10 February 2012. Those applicants, who desire to receive the document by courier shall have to pay Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) extra for delivery within India, or Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) extra for delivery outside India. The method of payment will be through demand draft in favor of the Project Director, Project Management Unit, Ports and Inland Water Transport Department, payable at Mangalore. No liability will be accepted for loss in transit or late delivery.

6. Bidding documents are also available on project website www.karnatakaports.in Eligible interested bidders can see and download the document and can participate in bidding procedure. Such bidders will submit cost of bidding document which is Indian rupees 2500/- (Rs. Two Thousand five hundred only) or in equivalent US dollar currency along with technical proposal through demand draft in favor of the Project Director, Project Management Unit, Ports and Inland Water Transport Department payable at Mangalore. No bids will be entertained without cost of bidding document.

7. **Bids must be delivered at Project Director, Project Management Unit, Ports and Inland Water Transport Department, Sustainable Coastal Protection and Management Project, Old Mangalore Port Office Building, Bunder , Mangalore Karnataka , India, on or before 1500 hours on 13 February 2012.** Technical bid must be accompanied by the bid security in the amount specified in the bid document .Late bids shall be rejected. Technical bids will be opened immediately after the deadline in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend. Bid security must be in the name of the lead partners.
8. Project Director Project Management Unit, Ports and Inland Water Transport Department will not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by Bidders in connection with the preparation or delivery of Bids.
